REQUEST FOR VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION

Optiscan Imaging Limited (ASX: **OIL**) (the **Company**) requests a voluntary suspension to the trading of the Company's ordinary shares (OIL) quoted on the Australian Securities Exchange (ASX) in accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.2.
