OPTISCAN SCALES DOWN BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Optiscan reported at the AGM on Monday of last week that the continuing review of operations and cost structures would include a restructuring of its board and management.

As part of this process, the board has decided to reduce the number of directors, and as a consequence, Jim Fox has will retire with effect from 30 November 2008. This reduces the board to four directors, including two non executive directors: Grant Latta and Tony Rogers and two executive directors Vicki Tutungi CEO and Peter Delaney.

Optiscan Chairman Grant Latta thanked Mr Fox for his contribution.
